

# How to Sort and Dispose of Resources and Garbage Properly

Please take your recyclable resources, burnable trash and non-burnable trash to your designated collection site by 8:00 a.m. on the collection day.

<b>Burnable Trash</b> Twice a week	<b>Biodegradable Trash</b> Kitchen scraps, clam shells, egg shells, etc.	Place items in containers with lids or in transparent garbage bags.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Drain kitchen scraps of water before disposal.</li> <li>● Absorb cooking oil using paper or cloth or with a solidifying agent</li> <li>● When disposing of bamboo skewers, please wrap them in paper with the words "キケン" clearly written on the wrapping.</li> </ul> There is a fee for the collection of large amounts of tree and hedge trimmings (branches, etc.). Please contact the Waste Collection Office. A collection fee is charged for all business-generated trash. Please attach garbage collection fee stickers before disposal.
	<b>Clothes, Wood Scraps</b> Blended fabrics, small amounts of wood scraps		
<b>Non-burnable Trash</b> Twice a month	<b>Paper Scraps</b> Tissue, disposable diapers, etc.	Place items in containers with lids or in transparent garbage bags so that the contents can be seen.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● When disposing of sharp objects, such as glass, needles and cutting instruments, wrap them carefully in paper with the words "キケン" clearly written on the wrapping.</li> <li>● Dispose of fluorescent lights and light bulbs in their original packages.</li> <li>● Dispose of spray cans after they are completely empty.</li> </ul> A collection fee is charged for all business-generated trash. Please attach garbage collection fee stickers before disposal.
	<b>Plastic Items</b> Styrofoam, plastic food wrap, food trays, plastic vinyl, etc.		
<b>Recyclable Resources</b> Once a week	<b>Rubber Items</b> Garden hoses, sandals, etc.	Separate recyclable paper according to type and bundle with string before disposal.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● PET bottles that contained cooking oil are not collected.</li> <li>● You can dispose of fillers inserted in newspapers together with your newspapers.</li> <li>● Collection is conducted on rainy days as well.</li> </ul> A collection fee is charged for all business-generated trash. 	<b>Leather Items</b> Briefcases, shoes, leather clothes, etc.		
	<b>Metal items, glass products, ceramics/pottery, fluorescent lights, etc.</b>		
	<b>Electrical appliances measuring less than 30 cm on any side.</b>		
<b>PET bottles</b> Bottles with PET recycling mark	<b>Disposal Method</b> ① Remove bottle caps and labels. *Dispose of caps and labels as burnable trash. ② Rinse the inside with water. ③ Squash the bottles. ④ Place the bottles in transparent bags and dispose of them in the designated collection site.	Place bottles and cans in separate transparent bags so that the contents can be seen.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Rinse the inside before disposal.</li> <li>● Take "returnable" bottles, such as beer bottles and "ishho" bottles for sake back to the store of purchase.</li> </ul> A collection fee is charged for all business-generated trash. 	<b>Newspapers, Magazines, Cardboard</b>		
	<b>Items that are not collected as recyclable resources:</b> Envelopes with glassine windows, thermal paper, non-carbon paper, photographs, paper cups, plastic-coated paper, paper cosmetics boxes		
	<b>Items that are not collected as recyclable resources:</b> Cosmetics bottles, bottles for oil, light bulbs, fluorescent lights, glasses, cups, ceramics/pottery, products made from heat-resistant glass, broken bottles		
<b>Glass bottles for foods and beverages</b>	<b>Items that are not collected as recyclable resources:</b> Spray cans (be sure they are empty), "itto" cans, cans for oil, cans for paint	Place bottles and cans in separate transparent bags so that the contents can be seen.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Rinse the inside before disposal.</li> <li>● Take "returnable" bottles, such as beer bottles and "ishho" bottles for sake back to the store of purchase.</li> </ul> A collection fee is charged for all business-generated trash. ## Recycling of Household Personal Computers

A collection/recycling fee is charge for personal computers purchased before October 2003.

- Laptop computers ¥3,150
  - Desktop computers (main body) ¥3,150
  - Braun-tube (CRT) Screens ¥4,200
  - LCD screens ¥3,150
  - CRT screens (single-body computer) ¥4,200
  - LCD screens (single-body computer) ¥3,150
- The above-mentioned fees may vary according to the manufacturer.



Since the collection/recycling fee is included in the sales price for personal computers with the PC Recycling Mark sold in or after October 2003, there is no fee charged at the time of disposal.

## The following items are not collected by the city.

Fire extinguishers, car batteries, motorcycles, tires, kerosene items, paints, chemicals, pianos and safes

For disposal of these items, contact the store of purchase or ask a specialized company. (The Waste Collection Office can introduce you to a specialized company that will help you.)

Please cooperate in the proper disposal of trash, in consideration of residents who offer the space in front of their homes as garbage collection sites.

## Collection Schedule for Recyclable Resources and Garbage for Each Area

● Garbage is collected on regularly scheduled days, including national holidays, except during the year-end/New Year holidays and on Sundays.  
 ● All business-generated trash, including recyclable resources, is collected for a fee. (Please affix the proper amount of stickers before disposal.)
